HAPPENINGS

International Forum on Quality & Safety in Healthcare

Parkway Pantai participated in the International Forum on Quality & Safety in Healthcare held from 24-26 August at Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre. Tan Sri Abu Bakar Suleiman, Chairman of IHH Healthcare, delivered a keynote presentation on Malaysia's healthcare system prior to the opening ceremony. Next, Dr Tan See Leng, CEO and Managing Director of IHH Healthcare, spoke at length about the aims, ambitions and challenges faced in putting patients at the heart of

quality healthcare. More than 50 delegates across the Malaysia Operations Division (MOD) attended the conference to share their expertise with and learn from each other for the benefit of the hospitals they represent. The conference, which had close to 1,000 delegates, explored key issues and initiatives in improving quality and safety in healthcare across five main streams – quality, cost, value; population and public health; building capability and leadership; safety; person and family-centred care.







GP Connect Referral Automation

MCO Marketing and IT launched the automation of General Practitioner (GP) Referral data capture in FiSiCiEN on 1 August. This process enhancement eliminates manual processing and monitoring of GP referrals currently managed by hospital marketing and front liners. The automation of GP Referrals also ensures that the hospital marketing team are able to monitor, profile and target their GP market segments more effectively and efficiently.

Sales Champion Training

MCO Marketing conducted a three-day Sales Champion Training from 18-20 August for 22 marketing team members managing B2B portfolios across six hospitals - GKL, PHKL, PHA, PHAK, PHBP and PHP. This is the first of a series of training that will be conducted for nationwide hospital marketing teams to equip them with sufficient knowledge, to share new skills and techniques, to enable the team to continuously assess and enhance their performances.





Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS) Campaign

Gleneagles Kota Kinabalu (GKK) ran a Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS) Campaign themed "Less Pain More Gains" throughout August. The campaign was aimed at raising awareness among the public on the benefits of MIS through an educational exhibition and public health talk. Visitors to the exhibition were given a "journey passport" for stamping from each exhibit which could be exchanged for a Coffee Bean cash youcher.

New Liquid Biopsy Testing

Pantai Premier Pathology (PPP) launched its new liquid biopsy testing in partnership with Sysmex Inostics and Merck Malaysia on 27 Aug. The liquid biopsy, aimed at monitoring the progression of metastatic cases of colorectal cancer and further aid diagnosis and treatment, is the first of its kind in Malaysia and Southeast Asia. The process is minimally invasive and results are available within seven days, providing oncologists and surgeons with quicker treatment decisions crucial for therapy success.





Safety Week

Safety has always been a top priority at our hospitals especially when it comes to patients requiring medical treatment. In line with this, Pantai Hospital Cheras (PHC) launched its Safety Week on 21 August with the theme "Safety is Gainful, Incident is Painful". A booth was set up in the lobby to create awareness on dengue prevention, medication safety and the dangers of smoking. A puppet show was featured to highlight safety in the operation theatre. Thanks to the creativity of PHC's nurses, the activities were a success.

Best of Bollywood

Staff at Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur (PHKL) were the stars of the evening during their Annual Dinner on 19 August held at Majestic Hotel. Themed "Best of Bollywood", the evening was abuzz with laughter and fun as staff, consultants and the management got together for Bollywood music, a scrumptious dinner, a comedy act by Harith Iskandar and in-house performances. Wound & Stoma Management Workshop

Nurses from Malaysia Operations Division (MOD) attended the Wound and Stoma Management Workshop held at Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur (PHKL) on 16-18 August. Aimed at training and equipping nurses with the right knowledge and skills in wound care and stoma management, the workshop also provided a platform for nurses to understand both the psychological and emotional challenges faced by patients with wounds and stomas.

Safety Month

In conjunction with Safety Month, the Gleneagles Penang (GPG) Infection Control Team launched a Hand Hygiene campaign on 12 August. The campaign was to promote the importance of washing one's hands to prevent the spread of infections and to save lives. Patients and staff are currently learning the seven steps of hand-washing. The Infection Control team has also arranged for the Ministry of Health Infection Control team to conduct a workshop for our healthcare workers, entitled "Prevention of Tuberculosis for Healthcare Workers".



Neurology Centre & Home Nursing Services

Pantai Hospital Sungai Petani (PHSP) officially launched its Neurology Centre and Home Nursing Services on 7 August. Officiated by YB Dato' Dr Leong Yong Kong, Kedah State Executive Council, the centre and services are the first of its kind at a private hospital in Kedah and Perlis. These initiatives are part of PHSP's aim of providing quality healthcare to residents within the area and neighbouring states while catering towards the social needs of the hospital's community.

Pantai Hospital Ipoh (PHI) recently organised a "Walk Your Way Towards Pain-Free Knees" event. THE ERASER DIET


When I stepped on the scale at my doctor's office, I was surprised to see that I weighted 144 pounds.





Dr Ravi Chandran has been an Executive Board member of AOFOG for the past 9 years. He has been actively involved in its educational activities and as Chair of the Constitutional Review Committee, was instrumental in revamping its Constitution.






Together with the team from the O&G Society of Malaysia, he spearheaded a very successful AOFOG Congress in 2015 which eventually led to the establishment of the "Malaysia Lecture" in subsequent AOFOG Congresses.

At the General Assembly in Hong Kong on June 2017, Dr Ravi Chandran was elected President of AOFOG. Since it's inception in 1957, Dr Ravi Chandran is only the 3rd Malaysian to have been accorded this honour.
