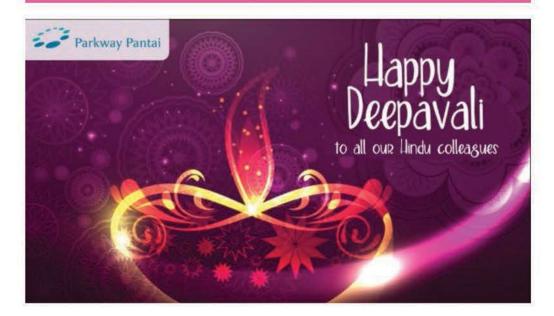

HAPPENINGS

Parkway Pantai Risk Forum

The second edition of Parkway Pantai's Risk Forum in Malaysia was held on 11 October. Staff from all levels turned up to gain further insight on risk management and current and possible threats in the cyber and medico-legal environment. The forum was opened by Linda Hoon, Group Head of Risk Governance, IHH Healthcare, who highlighted the importance of risk management as an integral component to the success of an organisation. This kicked off the topics for the day: Cyber Risk — Managing Disruption and Medico-Legal Updates — Managing the New Legal Landscape. Experts from each field took to the floor to expound on most recent issues and to recommend the best defenses moving forward. As a round up to the event, participants engaged in a lively discussion with a team of panelists. The session, moderated by Linda, saw questions being posed by individuals keen on seeking further information on managing and mitigating risks in their respective job scope in particular and in the hospital environment in general.

Pink October - "Wear It Pink" Charity Dinner

It was a night flushed with success at Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur's (PHKL) "Wear It Pink" Charity Dinner on 29 October. PHKL has been organising its Wear It Pink Campaign for more than 15 years to raise funds for underprivileged women suffering from breast cancer. The packed room of benefactors and celebrities, out in full support of women with breast cancer, were kept entertained by host Yasmin Yusoff, Sutra Academy Dancers and an LED troupe. PHKL presented a total of RM50,000 worth of breast prostheses and special mastectomy brassieres to 20 breast cancer patients, the National Cancer Society Malaysia and the Breast Cancer Welfare Association Malaysia.

Pink October - "Supporting You"

A total of 120 cancer patients and their family members from the northern region participated in the Cancer Patient Support Programme organised by Pantai Hospital Sungai Petani (PHSP) on 21 October. The event, themed "Supporting You", was aimed at providing cancer patients and their families with added support in battling and surviving cancer. Throughout the full-day programme, oncologists and dietitians from PHSP offered insights on coping with the disease. Other activities included exercises, group activities and an empowerment programme to enable patients to build networks of support groups for their overall well-being.





Pink October - "Love Yourself & Your Family"

Pantai Hospital Ipoh's (PHI) Pink October was themed "Love Yourself & Your Family". An event was held on 8 October which brought together breast cancer survivors, beauty queens and dancers from Persatuan Pink Champions. Some the activities organised were a unique contest where men had to dress as ladies and wear heels, a special performance by Taiwanese teen pop artists and Zumba workout. For the next two months PHI is promoting their specially-priced digital mammogram for the early detection of breast cancer.



Doctor For A Day

Gleneagles Medini (GMH) organised its very first "Doctor For A Day" event on 4 October. More than 70 children aged between 6-7 years old from neighbouring schools, Marlborough College Malaysia and R.E.A.L. Kids Nusa Idaman participated as Little Doctors. Some of the fun educational activities organised were hand hygiene station, anatomy room, health screening station, procedure room, doctor's room, nursery and emergency department station. The children had the chance to learn numerous healthcare skills and role-play in managing patients while guided by nurses.

The day was filled with educational and fun activities aimed at inspiring cancer survivors to live life to the fullest after cancer diagnosis and treatment.



"I Love My Heart" Campaign

In conjunction with World Heart Day, Gleneagles Kota Kinabalu (GKK) organised a I Love My Heart Campaign to raise awareness on heart health. The highlight of the campaign was a fund-raiser held on 9 October. Proceeds were raised through a charity photoshoot and donated to the Society of Sabah Heart Fund in aid of children with congenital heart diseases. There were also free basic health screenings, free echo scans, quit-smoking clinics and a lucky draw with the grand prize of a fitness watch worth RM1,500. A month-long educational exhibition was open to the public at GKK's lobby.

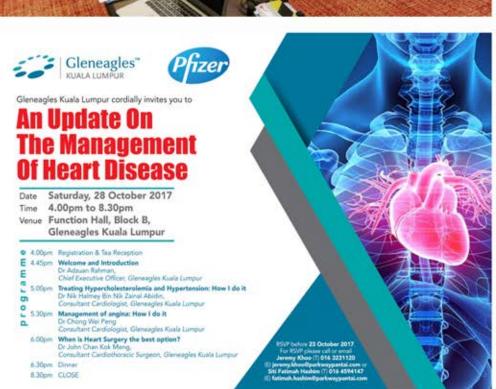

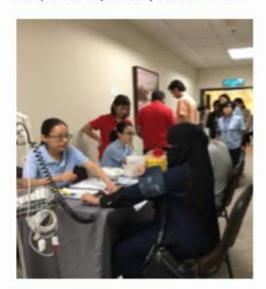






GKL CELEBRATES WORLD DIABETES DAY

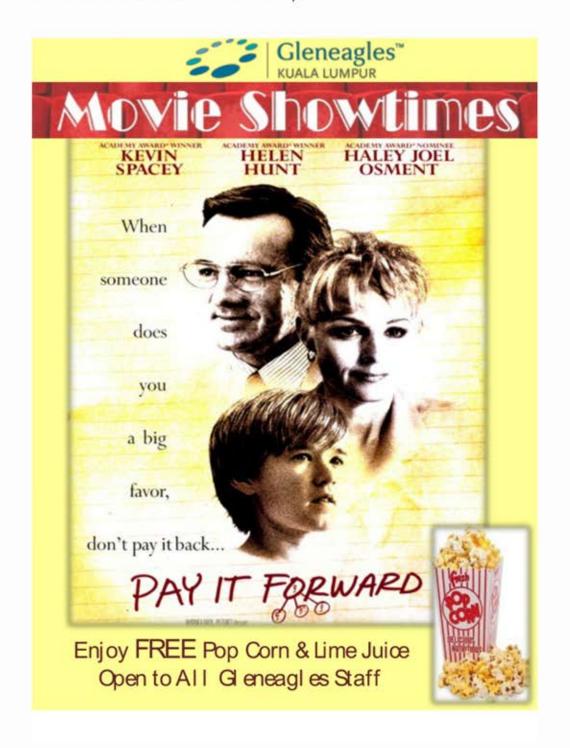
